Friendly Ave. and go left (west) on W. Friendly. Go about 1/4 mile west on W. Friendly to Chimney Rock Rd. and turn right (north at traffic light) on Chimney Rock Rd. As Chimney Rock Rd. parallels the new highway, you will come to the intersection of Ballinger Rd. Turn right on Ballinger and go under the new highway. Shortly beyond the overpass Leonard Recreation Center will be on your left. FROM EAST OF GREENSBORO Take Bus-40 through Greensboro Take Exit 24B (To Bryan Blvd. PTI Airport).
