Centrifugal clutch - zero motion at idle

Guarded trigger speed control

Double hand handle

Ergonomic handle

Ease of starting

Automatic blade oiler

Two-cycle v four-cycle

Gasoline life - low boilers

# Safety handout

# Watch out for

Kickback

Sand

Mud

Hidden obstacles behind the trunk you are cutting

Bees & biting ants

Pinching on the blade

#### Safe use

Not intended as a hollowing or sculpting tool

Keep the blade sharp

Proper stance

Bring the wood to you

Don't overreach

Goggles with side protection

Gloves

Hearing protection

Dust mask

Proper clothing - button-up shirt, boots & long pants

Keep it on the ground

Don't cut on nose or back of blade

Watch out for obstacles behind the blade

# Selection & Felling

Trunk v branches

Workable time after felling

Hinge

Ropes, mauls, wedges, sledge hammer

Obstacles

### **Planking**

Air dry one month per 1/4inch thickness

Kill to 6 - 8% - moisture meter

Seal ends and force moisture out the face to minimize end splits

# **Blocks**

Cube & seal
